## the growing Bed Bug problem

**month  
one**

one bed bug will lay  
2 to 8 eggs per day

that equals 60 to 240  
eggs in one month

the first  
batch of  
bed bugs  
eggs can  
start to  
hatch in  
6 days

if one egg  
was laid per  
day, 26 will  
start feeding  
on blood by  
the end of  
the month

**month  
two**

in the first  
week, your  
first bed bug  
hatchlings  
will look for  
a blood-meal

male and female  
hatchlings ratio is  
about the same  
(1:1 ratio)



every day, 2 new  
females will start  
depositing eggs

thats 8 eggs daily

at the end of the second  
month a total of 440 eggs  
will be laid

334 bed bugs  
will start  
feeding at the  
end of the  
second month

**month  
three**

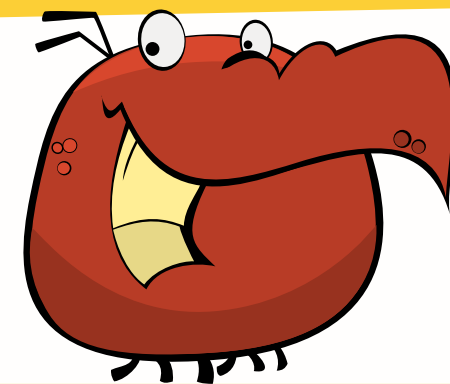
the start of a  
major bed bug  
infestation has begun

by the middle of  
the month

975 eggs have  
been laid

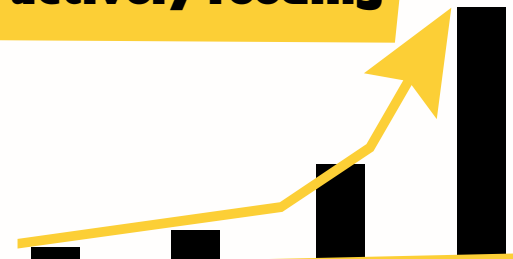
1,335 adults are  
now actively feeding

half of

three**

increased by 190%

eggs have  
increased by 281%
